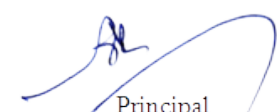

BRIEF REPORT ON ONLINE LECTURE

Topic: Partition and the Refugee Crisis: Issues of Migration, Loss and Resettlement

Objectives of the Program

1. To create awareness about the historical processes leading to the Partition of India and its consequences.
2. To sensitise students to the human dimensions of Partition, particularly migration, displacement, loss and resettlement.
3. To provide a broader understanding of Partition through national and global perspectives.
4. To promote awareness of the importance of peace, coexistence and social harmony.

Report

The Department of Political Science, Manikpur Anchalik College, in collaboration with IQAC, organised an online lecture on "Partition and the Refugee Crisis: Issues of Migration, Loss and Resettlement" on 14th August 2026, in observance of Partition Horror Remembrance Day-2026.

The lecture was delivered by Dr. Jayanta Krishna Sarmah, Professor, Department of Political Science and Head, Department of Philosophy, Gauhati University. He explained the historical processes leading to Partition and vividly discussed its human consequences, including migration, displacement, loss and resettlement. He also placed the Indian experience in a wider global context by referring to Korea, Vietnam, Yugoslavia and the Soviet Union.

The lecture was highly informative and engaging and enabled the participants to understand Partition not merely as a political event but also as a profound human experience.

A total number of 130 participants were present in the lecture (Annexure-I : Attendance)

Outcomes of the Programme

1. Participants gained a clearer understanding of the historical and political processes associated with Partition.
2. Students developed greater awareness of the experiences of refugees, migration, displacement and resettlement.
3. Participants gained a broader perspective by relating the Indian experience to examples of political division and disintegration in other parts of the world.
4. The programme encouraged sensitivity towards human suffering and reinforced the values of peace, coexistence and social harmony.

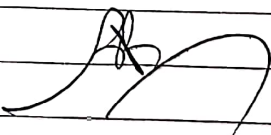

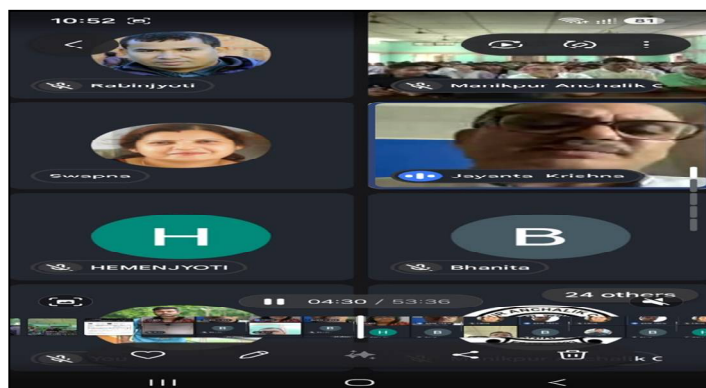
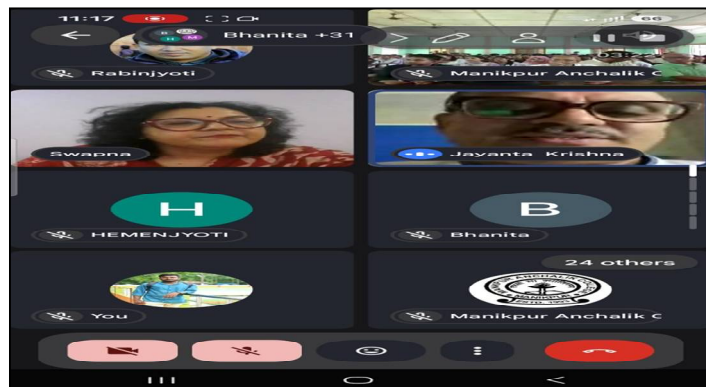
