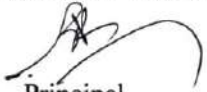

#### Introduction

An Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme was organised by the Anti-Ragging Committee of Manikpur Anchalik College on 10-08-2026 at Hall no -04. The programme was organised with the objective of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and the importance of maintaining a safe, friendly and respectful academic environment.

#### Objectives of the Programme

- To create awareness among students about ragging and its harmful consequences.
- To inform students about the rules and regulations relating to ragging.
- To make students aware of the legal and disciplinary consequences of ragging.

#### Proceedings of the Programme
